## Areas of Feedback:

The revised proposed procurement timeline presented on May 4, with regards to changes to the schedule of the Deliverability Test process.	Boralex appreciates that the IESO modified the deliverability schedule to allow for more time between deliverability results and RFP submission.
The proposed broadened definition of an Eligible Expansion facility, which gives the optionality of connecting to a separate connection point as long as the new resource remains within the boundaries of the existing site.	We understand and are grateful for the clarification and broadened definition of Eligible Expansion facility.
The removal of locational Rated Criteria points due to a provincial wide Capacity need within the timeframe of the LT1 RFP.	Boralex is amenable to the removal of the locational Rated Criteria points for the LT1 RFP.

## Other or General Comments/Feedback:

### Deliverability Test

#### Section 5.0

It is Boralex's opinion that Transmitters should identify their methods and assumptions when developing their methodology for short circuit test. Transmitters' methods and assumptions should be shared with proponents prior to June 16 deliverability test submissions.

#### Section 5.6 System Dynamics

In section 5.6 it indicates that the IESO will establish test assumptions, it would be helpful if the IESO released these assumptions prior to deliverability test submission to allow proponents to run their own models.
