Out-of-market Operator Actions	OPG	As the IESO has stated that the impact of control actions should be prevented from providing counter-intuitive prices is the IESO proposing that for Shared Activation of Reserve, the pricing will change from today's current method?	Consistent with the status quo, SAR activations will be reflected in price. Under SSM, SAR and activations of internal operating reserve will be consistently modeled between the dispatch and pricing runs. Note that SAR activations are substitutes for internal operating reserve activations.
