Summary

The IESO proposes to amend the market rules to enable the demonstration of demand response (DR) capabilities through pilot programs in the IESO-administered markets (IAM). These rules would enable industry to demonstrate the capability to enter and operate within the IAM effectively, and allow the IESO to identify potential barriers to entry to the IAM. DR pilots would provide an opportunity to discover the type of market rule amendments that would be required for permanent inclusion in the market rules, based on practical experience with the pilots.

This proposal is based on stakeholder consultation as part of the Demand Response Working Group (DRWG) and public sessions.

Background

Ontario's 2013 Long-Term Energy Plan¹ (LTEP) established a target "to use Demand Response to meet 10% of peak demand by 2025." The LTEP also signaled that the responsibility for existing and new DR initiatives will be transferred from the OPA to the IESO.

With respect to the capacity associated with the OPA DR2 contracts that will expire at the end of 2014, the IESO has received encouragement from the Ministry of Energy² to allocate a portion of this capacity to implement DR pilot initiatives in order to test DR's capability to meet system needs and to allocate the remaining capacity through the first IESO DR auction which is expected to occur in 2015.

The DR2 contracts expire at the end of 2014. A portion of the DR2 capacity will be allocated to the DR pilot initiatives, with the remaining capacity being allocated to the DR auction expected to take place in 2015.
