# Context

- The Minister issued amended directives to the IESO to effect changes arising from the 2017 Long-Term Energy Plan
- This presentation includes the key activities and linkages associated for two items:
  - In Front of the Meter Conservation projects (IFMC)
  - Timeline for Combined Heat and Power projects that use fossil fuels

# In-Front of the Meter Conservation (IFMC)

- **Key Deliverable:** The government, working with the IESO and OEB, will allow distributors to use the electricity savings from IFMC measures to meet their targets for electricity savings under Conservation First Framework (CFF)
- **Scope of Engagement Activities:** To prepare for this transition, the IESO will complete the following activities:
  - Work with the OEB on parameters for the review process, guidelines and processes needed for LDC rate applications and to include IFMC projects in LDC CDM Plans
  - Host a webinar Q1 2018 to solicit feedback from LDCs and interested parties on moving forward with IFMC

# Combined Heat and Power Projects (CHP)

- **Key Deliverable:** CHP projects powered with fossil fuels will not be eligible for incentives under the Conservation First Framework or Industrial Accelerator Program by July 1, 2018
- **Scope of Engagement Activities:** To prepare for this transition, the IESO will complete the following activities:
  - Work with LDCs in advance of the deadline to ensure consistency on transitional issues (e.g. projects in progress)
  - Provide education to the broader community and targeted stakeholders about the change to program rules
