Current Engagement Initiatives - Status Update

Brant Local Demand Response Pilot	The IESO's regional planning process has identified the recommendation to investigate opportunities for a DR pilot in the Brant area. The IESO is seeking to gather information from load customers in the Brant area through a questionnaire to assist in the development of the pilot. The IESO is planning to post a draft Request for Proposal later this fall and will hold a webinar to discussion and seek feedback on the RFP.
Capacity Exports	Meeting held on September 28 to discuss proposed market manual amendments - all stakeholders can comment on draft amendments through the IESO's Pending Changes process. Next steps of this engagement will be aligned with Market Renewal initiative.
Enabling System Flexibility	The objective of this engagement is to determine potential solutions that can enable and achieve flexibility to meet the evolving needs of the system. The IESO received feedback from stakeholders on the nature of the flexibility need and a range of potential options to address it. The IESO will respond to stakeholder feedback and plan for the next meeting in Q4.
Market Renewal	Discussions among the Market Renewal Working Group members continue to inform the next steps of this engagement - including recent discussions on sector benefits, implementation costs and market evolution. Discuss preliminary results of benefits case with all stakeholders in Q4.
Mid-Term Review - Conservation Framework	In response to stakeholder input, the launch of this engagement initiative will be pushed back.
Province-Wide Pay-for-Performance	The IESO has posted a response to feedback from participants on the draft program design and expects to hold a webinar in late-October to present the draft program participation documents for comment.
Province-Wide Whole Home Pilot Program	The IESO has responded to feedback received from participants in this initiative on the draft design. The IESO will announce next steps shortly.
Prudential Review - 2016	As part of a regular review conducted on a three year cycle, the IESO is reviewing the current real-time market prudential framework. Participants in this initiative have provided feedback that was considered in the development of the draft 2016 Prudential Framework Report. Participants can now provide comments on the draft report.
Real-Time Generation Cost Guarantee	A meeting is scheduled for October 13 to discuss and seek comment on the draft market manual amendments. The Technical Panel is in the process of reviewing draft market rule amendments.
