Granting of this exemption will not threaten the ability of the IMO to direct the operations and maintain the reliability of the grid, threaten the ability of the IMO to ensure non-discriminatory access to the grid, affect the ability of the IMO to operate the IMO-administered markets in an efficient, competitive and reliable manner, or give the exemption applicant an undue preference within the IMO markets. The applicant believes that there would be no increased costs to the IMO or other market participants with the granting of this exemption.

This facility in service on the date that this obligation or standard to which this application relates came into force.

The applicant is requesting an exemption from section 7.4.1 (k) of the Wholesale Revenue Metering Standard that states that the "cabling from the instrument transformers to the meter enclosure shall be routed in dedicated conduit, and the route shall be visually traceable". The cabling from the instrument transformers to the meter enclosure is in dedicated conduit, but the route is not visually traceably due to the embedded conduit. The applicant feels that the embedded conduit does not impose any errors or affect the metering accuracy or integrity of the installation. The granting of this exemption would have no adverse affect on the IMO-administered market or other market participants. The installation of embedded conduit is a common practice used at many electrical facilities.

The costs associated with complying to this requirement may be considered minimal, however, the removal of the embedded conduit would result in unnecessary exposure of the secondary circuits to the elements. The applicant feels that the use of the embedded conduit is both practicable and reasonable in these installations.
