Sector Priorities

Our sector appreciates the work that has been done on the Global Adjustment by the IESO since we last highlighted this issue as a priority. We feel there is still much work to be done. Our members continue to request increased transparency of the true market costs within the Global Adjustment so that we may budget and operate our electrical systems in a more cost effective way. Recent IESO efforts to provide educational sessions on the Ministry of Energy's regulatory reallocation of Global Adjustment for Class A consumers in Ontario were appreciated and well received by our members. We request that the IESO continue efforts to both increase the transparency of Global Adjustment and to provide education and public awareness of the improvements that are made.

Secondly, many of our Public Service Sector members are pursuing alternative energy projects to varying degrees of magnitude. It is important for our members to have the IESO support the integration of these renewable projects in an efficient way. We request that the IESO dedicate the required resources to help ensure these projects are able to become reality in a timely fashion for our sector.

And finally, in the near future, the Broader Public Sector will be required to comply with the regulatory requirements of the Green Energy and Economy Act. This will include a mandate to produce energy plans with specific goals and reduction targets. So we therefore continue to be supportive of the IESO's efforts to publicize the data and information that is necessary to allow our members to make informed decisions when managing their energy usage.

We also appreciate the opportunity to articulate these priorities and look forward to having them integrated into future IESO business planning cycles.
