Transmission Priorities for IESO, 2012 – 2014

Hydro One does not see the priorities of the IESO fundamentally changing as they relate to transmission. In particular, coordinating the reliability of Grid remains paramount. We need to continue to work together as an industry to represent Ontario's interests within the North American Grid. We also need to continue to focus on the effective connection and operations of new green generation.

Hydro One also sees an increasing need to collectively drive productivity and manage costs both within the IESO and those cost the IESO may cause the transmitter to incur. Over the past number of years we have worked well with the IESO to identify areas for cost savings, such as the outage planning processes, and been effective in realizing such savings. What we hope to achieve going forward is a continuation of indentifying opportunities to increase productivity and to act on them. Possible areas include further alignment of planning models and streamlining local area operating processes.

We presently work well with the IESO and the value of the SAC is in creating a broader awareness.
