

# Prioritization of IJTSC Related Initiatives and Actions

Inter Jurisdictional Trading Standing Committee  
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- The goal behind prioritization is to focus IJTSC efforts to key initiatives that remain outstanding and are considered to be of greatest benefit to the IJT community
- Determined through prioritized ranking of outstanding IJT initiatives and actions by IJTSC members and IESO staff

Rank of 1 – Item of Highest Priority

Subsequent Rank – Item of Lesser Priority

# How do we determine top priorities?

- Top priorities will be determined through averaging of member submitted rankings
- Each market participant is entitled to one set of rankings
- All submissions are averaged, giving equal weight to each “vote”
- Items with lowest average have highest priority
- Initiatives submitted without a ranking are excluded from the average calculation
