Subject: CAOR and Recallable Transactions IJT

All Traders,

At the most recent IJT meeting we discussed the option of biasing all recallable transactions to MISO and HQ after the one hour out pre-dispatch. The biggest risk of this option being that MISO would cease to accept recallable transactions.

Over the past few days MISO has not accepted a number of transactions that have been made recallable for CAOR. These transactions have been curtailed and coded with TLRe in the same manner as those transactions with New York. We are in the process of discussing this change in protocol with MISO to determine if they have implemented a change in policy going forward. That being said the viability of the option we discussed at the IJT is in question as it provides no further benefit.

We are committed to looking into other options and will provide further updates.
