The following is the *IESO's* assessment of the impact of the proposed *market rule amendment* on the interests of consumers with respect to price and the *reliability* and quality of electricity service.

Impact of Price:

Enabling the recovery of unwarranted congestion management settlement credit (CMSC) payments made to dispatchable loads will reduce uplift charges by redistributing any recovered payments back to market participants. While the materiality of such unwarranted CMSC payments is variable, individual CMSC events can be significant.
