As part of the IESO's commitment to increased transparency and data sharing in electricity planning, <u>load profiles</u> for two transformer stations (TS) in Niagara Region where there are emerging needs have been posted to the <u>engagement webpage</u>.

Hourly forecast data for Beamsville TS in the Town of Lincoln and Crowland TS in the City of Welland indicate potential electricity demand levels over the next 20 years. This information is used to help inform the type of technology, size, energy requirements and cost of potential solutions to address needs arising in 2023 in these areas.
