Dear participants,

You receive this email because you participated in the Transmission Rights (TR) Market Review engagement conducted in 2020-2021.

During the TR Market Review, stakeholders expressed interest in better understanding how the Net Intertie Scheduling Limit (NISL) works in today's market and the future renewed market. The IESO proposed to conduct an education session on NISL after the TR Market Review is completed, to help stakeholders better understand congestion due to NISL and its impact on prices. Additionally, the Review also identified the NISL Congestion and the real-time External Congestion Cost Residual Collection and Disbursement as an outstanding item to be included in the MRP scope.

The IESO has recorded an NISL education presentation and scheduled an engagement session on February 22 to discuss the NISL Congestion and the real-time External Congestion Cost Residual Collection and Disbursement.
