Engagement Plan

Adjustments to Intertie Flow Limits

Introduction

System conditions in the Northwest region of Ontario have impacted the export capability from this region. In August 2021, the IESO began to apply adjustments to interchange scheduling limits on the Manitoba and Minnesota interfaces to reflect reduced Ontario export capability. The IESO is proposing to add clarifying language to the market rules specifying when internal transmission constraints will be considered by the IESO in setting intertie flow limits.

Stakeholders and Communities

The IESO encourages all interested parties to participate in this engagement and provide feedback.

Engagement Objectives

The objective of this engagement is to seek feedback from market participants on the proposed market rule amendment language in advance of the review by the Technical Panel.

Approach
