Subject: Outage Process

Hello Engagement Team,

Recognizing the need for the outage process given the significant risk associated with the Capacity Test for the HDR resource, and the continued importance of a discussion on the audit process, AEMA submits the following proposal to verify if an outage is “real” for IESO to consider:

- o Submit contributor-level interval data for any site that we declared on outage at the same time as submission of aggregated data post-event
- o Have the IESO review outage data just like they assess resource performance based on the data sent
- o If the outage does not meet the requirements, then the IESO rejects the outage request
- o Then we (energy management company) have two days to resubmit that resource data that includes the data we previously excluded due to outage request
- o The IESO calculates performance based on the new submission

The benefit of this proposed process ensures that the outage process can stay in place while also avoiding the need to change anything related to the data audit process. It also gives the IESO the ability to validate the outages sooner and reduces administrative churn in the audit.
