Programs require a less stringent application processes. To further enable innovation, result oriented approaches that reduce formalities in the overall process are required. This would drive a results-oriented approach and would increase program uptake.

Are there additional program gaps that should be addressed?	As indicated in the mid-term review slide deck, a custom retrofit program is required to drive innovation and generate program interest. Opportunities in district energy and centralized heating/cooling plants would address program gaps while providing potential participants with an opportunity to decarbonize. If these types of projects are considered, system reliability and redundancy would improve.
