Scientists, politicians from all parties, and increasingly the public now recognize the existence of the climate crisis and the vital need to meet the international climate and greenhouse gas goals by 2030 and 2050.

Phasing out gas fired electricity is an important step towards critical climate goals. Because of this Ontario needs to phase out gas-fired electricity in Ontario by 2030.
