Can you comment on the type or types of Planning and/or Market data that you access from the IESO? Do you have any feedback for the IESO about the Planning and/or Market data that is currently made available to stakeholders?	SEC, as part of its interventions in various OEB proceedings, primarily accesses planning data for rate cases and LTC applications, but occasionally market data when it is required (e.g. the recent ETS Rate proceeding, assessment of OPG's optimization of its hydroelectric assets). As the Jurisdictional Review reveals, there are a number of areas where the IESO, especially as it relates to market data, lags peer system operators in what it makes available.

What additional Planning and/or Market data is your organization seeking to access? If possible, provide the data sets of interest including specifics details in terms of granularity, format, etc.	As noted in the Jurisdictional Review, the IESO lags other system operators in making available certain data available. This includes more granular market clearing price data, anonymized energy offer/bids, and SIS data.
