To help participants prepare for MRP Go-Live, the IESO has already begun to provide materials that support your planning and implementation activities, and will continue to provide more resources and additional support over the next 18 months.

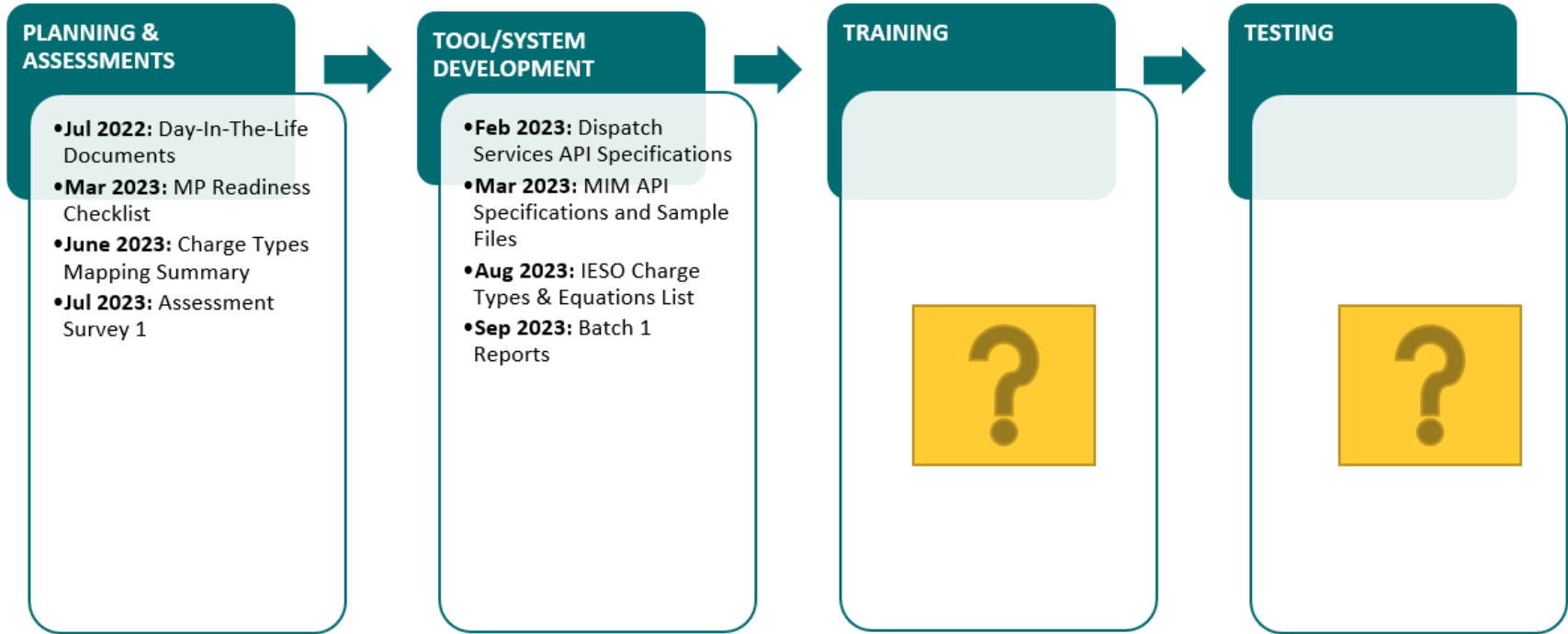

Training Formats

Training will be delivered in different formats:

- Online Interactive Modules
 - High-level overview of key change topics (e.g. Day-Ahead Market, Market Power Mitigation, Locational Marginal Pricing, etc.)
 - Market Overviews: a walkthrough of how market renewal impacts different resource types from registration to settlements. Live Q&A sessions will be scheduled at a later date to support market participants

Training Formats

- Written Guides, Quick Takes, and Instructions
 - Documents that provide in-depth information related to key change topics
 - Purpose is to supplement the reader's understanding of changes to the Market Rules and Market Manuals

 - Live demos that are focused on updates that were made to the user interface of impacted tools (Online IESO, EMI and Dispatch Services)
 - Provides market participants an understanding of how to use new forms and parameters in the IESO systems during market trials and after MRP Go-Live

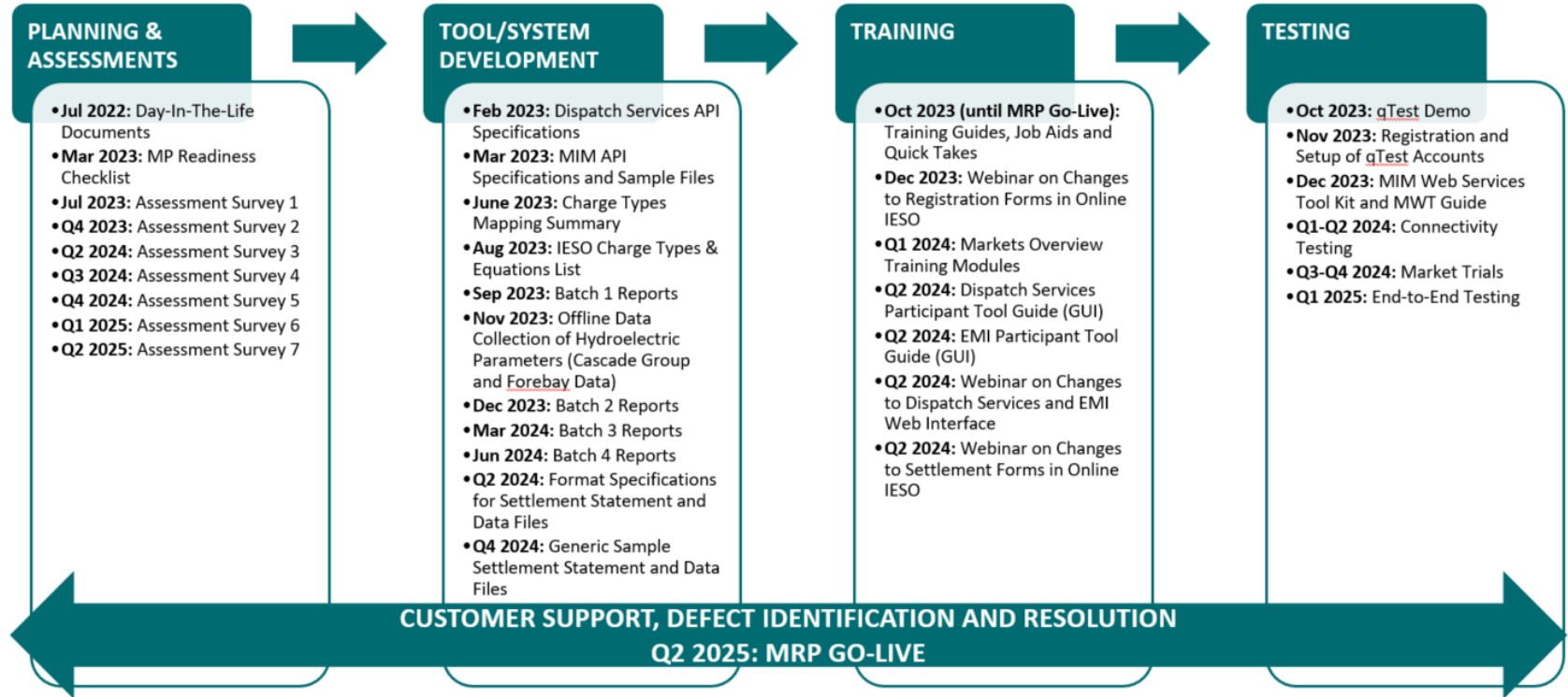
