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#### Market Participant Readiness

The changes introduced by the Market Renewal Program (MRP) impact each market participant (MP) differently. Impact is based on multiple factors such as participation type, organization size, the complexity and automation in your systems, and your level of engagement in this program thus far. 

### **Training Formats**

Training will be delivered in different formats:

- Online Interactive Modules

  - Market Overviews: a walkthrough of how market renewal impacts different resource types from registration to settlements. Live Q&A sessions will be scheduled at a later date to support market participants
