Follow-up: Market Rules for Appendix 7.1A and Appendix 7.2A

The IESO took an action item to provide a specific section reference to where the draft market rule amendments can be found for Appendix 7.1A and Appendix 7.2A. The amendment is under Chapter 7, Section 22.14.1.

The rule reads as follows:

22.14.1 The *IESO* shall, for *dispatchable resources*, apply a conduct test and impact test for *economic* withholding in any *dispatch hour* using *day-ahead market* and *real-time market reference levels* in the processes to determine *day-ahead schedules* and *pre-dispatch schedules*, respectively, as set out in Appendix 7.1A and Appendix 7.2A of the *market rules*.

This provision obligates the IESO to carry out ex-ante mitigation in the manner described in the cross-referenced appendices. These appendices will be the market rules that govern the day-ahead calculation engine and the predispatch and real-time calculation engines and will be part of a future market rules amendment, in Q2 2022.

The integration of ex-ante mitigation into the calculation engines was discussed at the August 2021 stakeholder session on the MPM batch, as noted in the <u>presentation materials</u> and the <u>presentation recording</u>.
