Context for LT2 RFP



Changing electricity landscape: Ontario is entering a period of need – by 2050, energy consumption could grow by 60%. To meet the emerging needs, a multi-pronged approach to meeting Ontario’s growing electricity needs is being implemented, including new supply and transmission.



A mix of resources will be required: To meet needs emerging starting in 2030, energy producing resources and capacity resources will be required to meet system needs.



What to expect regarding LT2 RFP: Proposal submissions expected to be due in 2025, protections for Prime Agricultural Areas, streamlined approach for community engagement, and continued promotion of Indigenous participation.



Your feedback is integral: Procurement design for both the LT2 RFP Energy and Capacity streams will be informed by input from Indigenous communities, municipalities, and stakeholders.

Indigenous Community Participation

The success of E-LT1 and LT1 RFPs is evidenced by significant Indigenous participation in projects. Building on this success the IESO will seek to mirror requirements from these past procurements:

- More rated criteria points were awarded based on increased levels of Indigenous economic interest
- Additional points were awarded to incentivize participation from Indigenous communities that were local to the project (i.e., communities who attested to the project being located on their traditional territory, treaty lands or homeland)

The IESO will seek to refine contractual parameters to ensure this success can continue.
