General Comments/Feedback

Northland Power would like to thank the IESO for its continued engagement with stakeholders throughout the development of the MT2 and LT2 RFPs. As guidance has been provided with respect to project siting constraints, there remains a lack of clarity around pre-bid deliverability assessments as well as how the IESO plans to conduct the deliverability testing during the evaluation stage of the LT2 RFP.

Northland Power encourages the IESO to consider conducting detailed deliverability assessments prebid, as seen in other markets, to ensure significant development dollars are not wasted on infeasible projects. Further, conducting detailed deliverability assessments early in the procurement would focus the time, resources and capital of communities and indigenous stakeholders on feasible projects. In the event there are constraints on resources that are preventing the IESO from performing deliverability assessments early in the process, Northland Power would support the idea of outsourcing pre-bid deliverability assessments to third parties and passing these costs onto the developer.
