<p>Do you have any comments for the IESO to consider regarding the proposed timeline for the first submission window?</p>	<p>The LT2 Window 1 submission deadline should be extended further into Q3 or into Q4 2025.</p> <p>This would help to ensure adequate time for meaningful engagement and partnerships with Indigenous Nations and municipalities and generate a greater number of high-quality project proposals.</p> <p>With municipalities taking summer recess during July and August, there is limited time and increased pressure to secure municipal support in a timeframe that conforms with RFP requirements.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do you have any comments for the IESO regarding the newly proposed rated criteria related to duration?</li> </ul>	<p>The requirement for 8-hour duration will limit the number and competitiveness of submissions that IESO will receive. The minimum duration for capacity resources should be amended to four (4) consecutive hours and the desire for proposals to include duration capabilities of eight (8) consecutive hours or more should be reflected in the award of rated criteria points.</p>

We also stress that the uncertainty regarding the Crown Land Site Report (CLSR) requirement (report contents and methodology for Ministry review) is of concern especially with the short and challenging timeframes from final RFP publication and proposed bid deadline.
