<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do you have any comments for the IESO to consider regarding the proposed timeline for the first submission window? 	<p>The proposed timeline for the LT2e first window is quite aggressive and the IESO has set a large target of 3 TWh for this window. The tight timeline may not see as much uptake in larger projects as these take more time to develop and thus the IESO may not achieve their target. SWEB Development suggests a later deadline in Fall 2025.</p>

Details provided during the presentation were vague but if it provides more details than the above mentioned Transmission Availability Tables, it could be a valuable tool for proponents.</p>
