LT1 RFP Design and Lessons Learned from E-LT1 RFP

<p>E-LT1 RFP: Please provide any general feedback reflecting on your participation in the E-LT1 RFP as it relates to the upcoming LT1 RFP.</p>	<p>Aypa Power appreciates the IESO efforts to re-engage the stakeholders of the LT1 RFP on Mar.28th . General feedback is that the planned changes pertaining to the MSR mandatory requirements and the Locational preferences need to be communicated much sooner.</p>
<p>LT1 RFP design: Please provide any feedback on the proposed Mandatory Requirement for Municipal Support.</p>	<p>Aypa Power understands and supports the need for the proposed Mandatory Requirement for Municipal Support, however the timeline between the LT1 Deliverability Test conclusion and the results targeted in Sept/Oct and the Proposal submission deadline targeted in Oct/Nov makes it difficult to timely obtain municipal support especially when development efforts may pivot based on the outcome of the Deliverability Test. Also, most of the municipal staff and councilors are generally not open to discussing LT1 projects until they pass the Deliverability Test and there isn't sufficient time between the deliverability test and bid submission date to engage municipalities, review and respond to councilor's Q&A, , get on councilor's meeting agendas and successfully secure municipal support</p> <p>Aypa Power recommends that the IESO provide a similar timeline to obtain Municipal Support to that provided under E-LT1.</p>
<p>LT1 RFP design: Please provide any feedback on the Rated Criteria Categories and Point Allocation.</p>	<p>Aypa Power supports the general consistency in establishing the rated criteria between the E-LT1 and LT1. However, late communication of changes to Location rating criteria and point allocation may disadvantage certain development projects and will leave proponents with limited time to digest, reflect on changes, and pivot accordingly.. Aypa Power recommends that the LT1 preferred locations and circuits ratings are issued at the beginning of May, or no later than the issuance of the LT1 Deliverability Guidance document targeted in mid-May, as communicated during the Mar 28th LT1 webinar.</p>
