Areas of Feedback:

Topic	Feedback
The revised proposed procurement timeline presented on May 4, with regards to changes to the schedule of the Deliverability Test process.	Could the IESO quickly clarify how many Deliverability Test submission will be allowed per Proponent
The proposed broadened definition of an Eligible Expansion facility, which gives the optionality of connecting to a separate connection point as long as the new resource remains within the boundaries of the existing site.	
The removal of locational Rated Criteria points due to a provincial wide Capacity need within the timeframe of the LT1 RFP.	This is an improvement for the competitiveness of the RFP

Other or General Comments/Feedback:

We respectfully submit that the IESO should allow existing facility/part of facility/project that have not been in operation or under a contract with IESO for more than 2 years to participate in the LT-1 RFP.

Proponent should also be allowed to change the technology that is currently interconnected.

The specificities of these projects should be taken into account in the Deliverability Test process and the already connected facility/project should be provided with a preferential access to the grid as it should result in increasing the competitiveness of the RFP.
