Feedback on the draft schedule	Atlantic Power supports the draft schedule as ambitious but achievable.
Feedback on the extension to the commitment term	Atlantic appreciates the IESO's recognition of the need for a longer-term commitment in specific cases. The 3+2 year approach is a reasonable compromise that recognizes the IESO's preference for commitments to expire in 2029 to align with the next MT RFP while offering an extended term option for those resources that require it for commercial reasons. Another option the IESO might also want to consider is to allow generators that are able to do so to commence the commitment period upon the expiration of their existing contract. Allowing this option (that may be up to a 2+3 year commitment) would reduce uncertainty for generators in the interim period while still meeting the IESO's objectives of expanded participation and competition in the next MT RFP at the end of the decade.
