Are there aspects to the transmission planning process that you need to know in more detail, specifically, in terms of opportunities to be informed and/or participate in the development of transmission plans?	It is recommended that the IESO provide some rigour to the siting/routing process that is proposed to be led by each Transmitter. For consistency and equity among transmitter projects, siting criteria should be somewhat prescribed (to the extent that it makes sense) so that all site selection processes are considering the same or very similar criteria. Some consideration to weighting factors for the criteria and sensitivity analyses of the results is also

	recommended. All three pillars of environment, economic and social need to be addressed in siting. Engagement expectations should also be clear – the public, municipalities, Indigenous, etc.
Based on your experiences, what are your key considerations to develop the Transmission Selection Framework?	With the development and operating/maintenance stages of transmission led by the Transmitters, it will be important to provide standardization in process and measurement of outcomes to the extent possible so that there is consistency in project development (e.g. siting/routing, community engagement) and performance monitoring.
