Regional electricity planning continues to advance for the East Lake Superior region to ensure a reliable supply of electricity and support local growth and economic development. This region extends from the Township of Dubreuilville in the north to the town of Bruce Mines and includes the City of Sault Ste. Marie and the Township of Chapleau.

An Integrated Regional Resource Plan (IRRP) will be developed, looking at the unique needs of the area, and will consider a range of options and resources to meet future needs. Your input will inform all aspects of this process. On Thursday, June 4 the IESO will host a webinar to share the detailed options analysis and seek input on the draft recommendations to meet this region's electricity needs.
