Regional planning looks at the unique needs of each region, and considers wire and non-wire options and innovative resources to meet the needs. The GTA West electrical region generally encompasses the municipalities of Brampton, Caledon, Halton Hills, Mississauga, Milton, Oakville and Burlington.
