What additional considerations, based on local developments, should be taken into account for the areas identified as requiring further study?	The City of Kingston is currently undertaking its Official Plan review. As part of that background studies were undertaken to project housing, employment and population. City Council adopted a growth scenario in December 2023 that projected the city to grow from 154,100 people in 2021 to 220,900 by 2051, representing 66,800 new residents, 29,300 new housing units and 33,400 new jobs over this period to 2051. Most of the expansion will take place within the existing urban boundary, but there will also be consideration of an expanded urban boundary. Planning Services has targeted the new Official Plan to be considered by Council for approval in Q2 of 2026.
