	<p>electricity 24 hours per day. We believe NRCan may have a program to assist the northern Indigenous communities with some funding support. We have a lender that will fund each project and provide a lease up to 20 years and after that time, the Indigenous community will have full ownership of their Magnetic Generator. This will give each Indigenous northern community ownership of their own electricity system, plus no other company will be required to forward any biomass or other type of fuel. We know IESO and the government have been reviewing the opportunity of providing many northern Indigenous communities with power delivered via a distribution system to power each and many Indigenous communities up north. The Magnetic Generator will work for 50 years and it will be on an annual maintenance and service each year.</p>
<p>What additional considerations, informed by local developments, should be taken into account for the areas identified as requiring further analysis?</p>	<p>The new energy system will provide power 24 hours per day and can provide customized independent power customized for the 43 Indigenous communities that are in the Sudbury/Algoma area. Each community can have independent power that will last them for 50 years. The generators do not need any fuel, they are powered by a magnet that will go round and around yearly for 50 years. The power system provides power all night long and that power can be used to help provide some heat or more electricity as the communities grow.</p>
<p>What other areas or specific considerations should be examined through regional planning?</p>	<p>Globally the world is soon going to be needing help to reduce the heat inside homes and inside buildings of all types and sizes. We can provide a Membrane that fits inside windo/ws and will significantly reduce the heating and cooling that will increase in homes and buildings, once the climate changes and the world will start to experience hotter temperatures daily. I live in St. Thomas and we have noticed some warmer weather and much less snow and more rain this year. Things are changing globally and many parts of the world will need some of our power systems to help control the heat for inside buildings.
