Regional electricity planning for the [Toronto](#) electrical region has advanced. The regional planning process looks at the unique needs of each electrical region in Ontario, and considers wire and non-wire options and innovative resources to meet electricity needs. In this region, an Integrated Regional Resource Plan (IRRP) is being developed, and your input will inform this important work.

On Thursday July 10 at 10:00 a.m., the IESO will host a [webinar](#) to share the results of the Options Screening for the Toronto electrical region, seek feedback and answer questions. During the webinar the IESO will also share draft results regarding a local achievable potential study that will identify and quantify electricity energy savings potential, electricity demand savings potential and associated costs attainable through energy efficiency and behind-the-meter distributed energy resources in the City of Toronto.
