What additional information, if any, should be incorporated in the proposed electricity demand scenarios? What are some of your key developments, projects or initiatives that should be considered in developing an electricity demand forecast for the Toronto region?	Stream 1a and 1b address high powered DC fast chargers and respectively L2 chargers, what seems to be missing is a gap we see in the market today. We are pointing at modular bidirectional DC charging (~30kW) scalable to 360kW+ . We have an opportunity to demonstrate how to deploy DC Networks incrementally, while mitigate infrastructure investment and unlocking grid capacity, buoying adoption, and providing grid edge flexibility. The mins # of chargers, cars and kW's etc would benefit from a calibration to align with solution approach.
