## **Summary**

The Task Force on Coordination of Planning (TFCP) and the Task Force on System Protection (TFSP) have completed a comprehensive review of Directory #7. This review considered the impact of evolving ERO Standards on the Criteria, emerging industry technologies, and recommendations from the Strategic Review of NPCC Criteria.

Key Updates from the Triennial Review:

- Alignment of the Criteria with applicable NERC standards (e.g., PRC-017)
- Identified requirements including R5, R6, R7, and R8 in PRC-012-2 that are not viable under the current single review process and removed their reference.
- Criteria updated to also require DC supply to "independently" annunciated to a 24-hour Operations center.
- Enhanced descriptions for monitoring and annunciation in R5.
- Enhanced and standardized formatting

### Cost Effectiveness:

In line with the Strategic Review of the NPCC Criteria, the TFCP solicited feedback from the Membership regarding the cost effectiveness and contribution to system resilience of the individual criteria attributes in Directory #7. The results of this evaluation have been documented in the permanent review record.
