Current system conditions in the Northwest region of Ontario are impacting the export capability from this region. Interchange scheduling limits on the Manitoba and Minnesota interfaces will be adjusted to reflect reduced Ontario export capability. These limits will come into effect on August 23, 2021, and will remain in effect until further notice.
