In Chapter 7, sections 2.2A.2, 2.2.3, 2.2.11, 2.2.12, 2.2.15, 2.2.16, 2.2.21, 2.2.22 and 10.2.2, the phrases "approve an application to register", "approve an application for registration" and "approved for registration" all have the same meaning. They all mean the facility's application for registration has been approved.		
To avoid any possible confusion as to whether those terms have different meanings, it is proposed that uniform terminology be adopted.		

PART 4 – PROPOSED AMENDMENT

2.2.12	A self-scheduling generation facility whose approved application for facility registration has been approved by the IMO is a registered facility.
2.2.16	An intermittent generator whose approved application for facility registration has been approved by the IMO is a registered facility.
2.2.22	A transitional scheduling generator whose approved application for facility registration has been approved by the IMO is a registered facility.
10.2.2	The <i>IMO</i> shall approve an application forto facility registeration of a facility as a registered facility for the provision of capacity reserve if the applying market participant submits the registration information required by this section 10.2 and the <i>IMO</i> is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the facility is capable of operating as described in the registration information.
2.2A.2	The <i>IMO</i> shall approve an application forto facility registrationer of a commissioning generation facility as a self-scheduling facility if it is satisfied that the requirements of section 2.2 have been met. Any such registration shall expire upon completion by the commissioning generation unit of the final commissioning test submitted to and approved by the <i>IMO</i> pursuant to section 2.2A.4.
